PUNTA GORDA ISLES FISHING CLUB RANDY'S FISHING REPORT

Well, I've been in Louisiana for the entire month of June on a personal matter and I'm STILL there! So, I haven't been able to fish but it's great to see the June Fishing Event conclude successfully. Congrats to the Redfish victors and Joe Udwari for his contribution of Red Snapper parts.

It's already the "dog days" of summer with record heat...and it's not even July yet! Good news is that the fishing pressure is reduced due to the heat and more of our fishermen are up north. Stay hydrated, keep one eye on the horizon for pop-up storms, and consider night fishing. Fish handling in the summer heat is extremely critical. Long fights may be fun, but the low oxygen content in the harbor really stress the fish out. A quick well-handled release is key to its survival.

July is SHARK month. Remember that you don't have to physically measure nor boat the shark; only a photo of the fish is required. You don't even have to classify the shark. Medium to heavy gear is essential. Wire leaders and heavy hooks raise your success rate. Think about wearing gloves to handle the leader since the joints and crimps can easily cut your hand. Often the easiest and safest release technique is to simply cut the leader.

Best area (that I know of) to find many species of shark is the "Harbor Shark Triangle" formed by Bokeelia to Cape Haze to Burnt Store. Start near the bright yellow buoy markers of the Cape Haze Artificial Reef. Use large live or dead bait fish and rig a few at different depths until you figure it out. Bonnetheads are plentiful on the grass flats all along the East wall. They're great to go after if you don't have heavy gear. Good luck and always be thinking about what could go wrong when you've got it hauled up to your reach.

Fish of the Month July – Shark



- Found in various water depths; 3' and beyond
- Found near the flats, deep holes, passes, wrecks; just about any where
- Feed on live or dead bait
- Frozen chum can be effective in shallow water to attract them
- SharkTooth works well attached to fluorocarbon

- Sharks do not need to be boated; estimate the length using a rod, the boat, etc
- Most points win 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place
- Estimated '5 = 3 points less than "5 = 1 point
- Visit FWC to determine if you need a shark permit if fishing from shore; residents over 65 years may need a permit based on certain factors



Fishing Events

With the continuation of limitations on Club meetings, we will plan at least some small events to hopefully keep members engaged in Fishing Club activities.

The Month in Review (June)


Record Keeper: Paul Whiting



Looks like the summer season has finally inflicted its downward numbers on our totals with only half as many reported catches by half as many anglers. The FOM – Jack Crevalle – proved to be elusive, bending the rods of only 7 anglers. Seatrout responded nominally with 15 reported catches. Red grouper continued to cooperate offshore accounting for 8 catches but the quest for red snapper was a bust. More were actually caught earlier in the year. The Fitzgerald's and the McKenna's put a real hurting on the redfish during our tournament, but Mike White's new club record coming in late in the month at 47" was a monster of a bull red. A total of 25 redfish were reported. Bill Muir attained two rungs on his LOA in one month, earning both the Snook and Redfish pins. Paul Whiting also earned two rungs (Silver and Gold). There were 6 changes in the MAT and 3 changes in the Isles Trophy. 5 anglers achieved a new rung(s) on their LOA. Joe Udwari has amassed a total of 4800 points already this season, on his way to best his 2018 total of 6600 points.

PUNTA GORDA ISLES MARINE WATCH HELP US TO HELP YOU



What is Punta Gorda Isles Marine Watch ("PGI Marine Watch")?

PGI Marine Watch is a volunteer on-the-water and land surveillance program like no other in Southwest Florida. The program was founded over ten years ago by Bill Guenther, a PGI resident, when he identified a need for increased security in the canals because of the increasing number of homes being built and residents moving to Punta Gorda Isles. Our group works in conjunction with the Punta Gorda Police Department, as a watch and report program. We act as a deterrent to those individuals who may be considering the theft of a boat or other



marine equipment, as well as illegal netting activity. Since its inception in 2009, the PGI Marine Watch has been an active part of reducing marine crime in Punta Gorda Isles.




What do our members do?

The volunteer members of the PGI Marine Watch use their own boats to patrol once a month for a two hour period. Some of our members partner with another PGI Marine Watch member and complete their patrol together, alternating boats. Some of our members patrol with a friend or their spouse. The patrol dates are flexible to fit your schedule and once your patrol is complete you email your report for the program records.

What is required to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch?

The only requirement to volunteer with the PGI Marine Watch is a desire to help your community. The PGI Marine Watch program provides you with signage for your boat and works with you to determine which patrol area works best for you based upon where you reside. The preferred boat size is at least 19 feet in length due to the occasional rough waters in Charlotte Harbor, with either a T-top or bow rail to display the "PGI Marine Watch" sign. Our PGI Marine Watch volunteers also are authorized to receive a 5% fuel discount at Fisherman's Village Marine.






How can I join?




